Intrada announces the premiere stereo release of the complete score to *The Barbarian and the Geisha* by Hugo Friedhofer. 20th Century-Fox released the movie as one of their prestigious Cinemascope presentations in 1958. Helmed by famed director John Huston and starring no less than John Wayne, this exotic costume adventure combined 19th century fact and Hollywood fiction to tell a story of Ambassador Townsend Harris and his exploits in Japan.

For this movie, Friedhofer contributed one of his richest, most spectacular scores. Boasting a vast array of oriental percussion, this large-scale orchestral work features one of the richest love themes to grace the screen. Colorful set pieces, suspenseful intrigue, action - all are featured on this special limited edition. Prepared directly from the original stereo session elements, including complex mixes of Friedhofer's huge percussion arsenal, this CD contains a wealth of powerful music not included on the original mono Fox label LP released in 1958.
