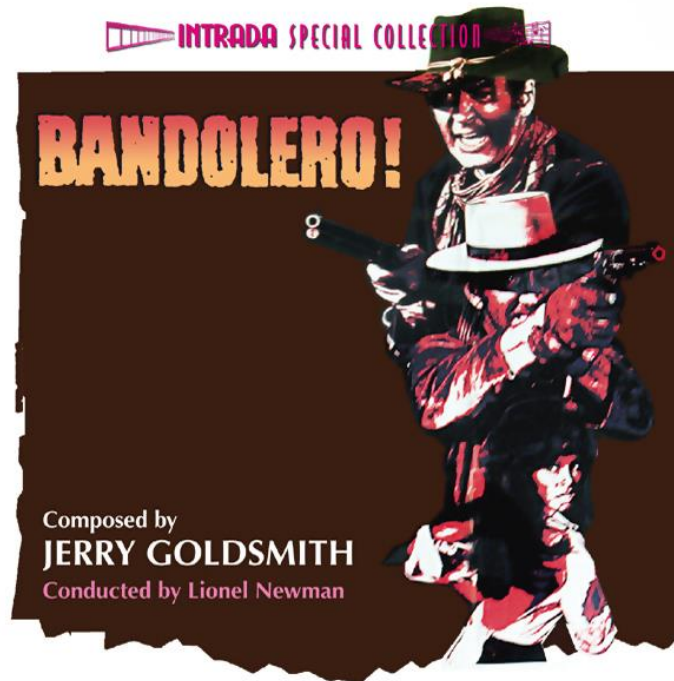

When Dee Bishop (Dean Martin) and his gang hold up a bank in Val Verde, Texas, they land swiftly in jail. Their cell affords them a clear view of the construction of the gallows from which they will hang. All is not lost, however, as the out of town hangman is "detained" en route by Mace Bishop (James Stewart), who masquerades as the hangman and frees his friends. During the gang's escape, Maria Stoner (Raquel Welch) is kidnapped. They steal the wrong woman: Sheriff July Johnson (George Kennedy) is in love with Stoner, and takes up relentless pursuit of the gang into Mexico, which leads them all into the treacherous territory of the Mexican Bandoleros...ruthless, deadly predators.

Newly-expanded from the original 28-minute album, Intrada presents the world-premiere complete edition mastered directly from the original multi-track stereo elements. In a mix entirely different from the original album, listeners will now hear an array of percussion, including castanets, Jews harp, guitar, harmonica and more with a clarity not previously realized. As a bonus, the original album mix will be offered as well, allowing collectors to enjoy whichever version they choose. Amongst several previously-unreleased selections are a lengthy, exciting pursuit sequence by George Kennedy and his posse as well as the somber "Procession to the Gallows" cue.
