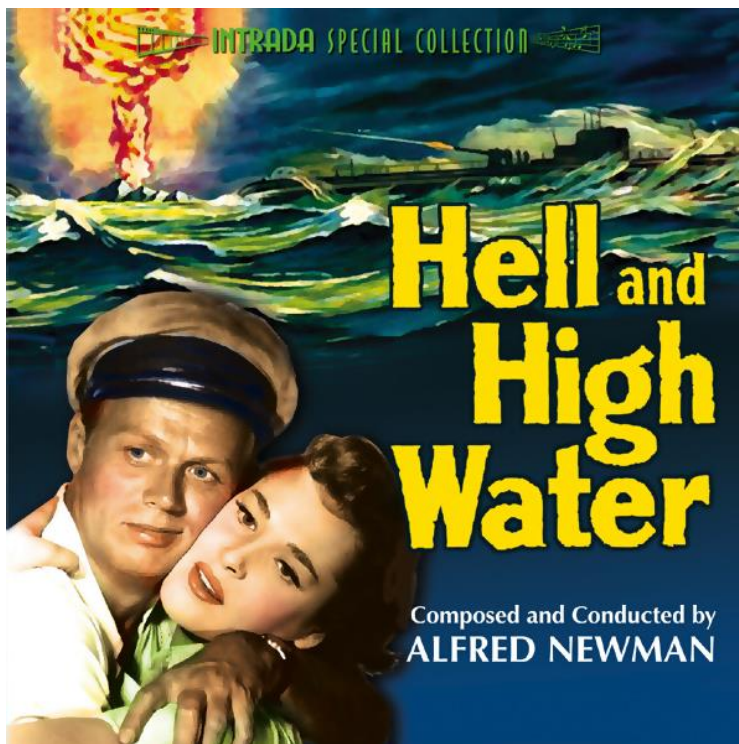

HELL AND HIGH WATER

20th Century Fox's submarine spectacle *Hell and High Water* (1954) features Richard Widmark as an ex-Navy captain who's lured by the sum of \$50,000 from a private financier to transport a French scientist in a submarine to an Arctic Island. It's not just any Arctic Island, but the destination of a Red Chinese freighter that they're following – one suspected of engaging in a plot to launch an atomic bomb at the United States. *Hell and High Water* was helmed by cult favorite Samuel Fuller, who brought his tough guy sensibilities to this two-fisted thriller.

Hell and High Water is given solid support from veteran Alfred Newman with his dynamic score, including an especially powerful opening and lengthy music for underwater action. Intrada presents the entire score (over an hour) in stereo from the original 35mm magnetic tracks. Also included are "bonus tracks" featuring source music plus unused and alternate cues.
