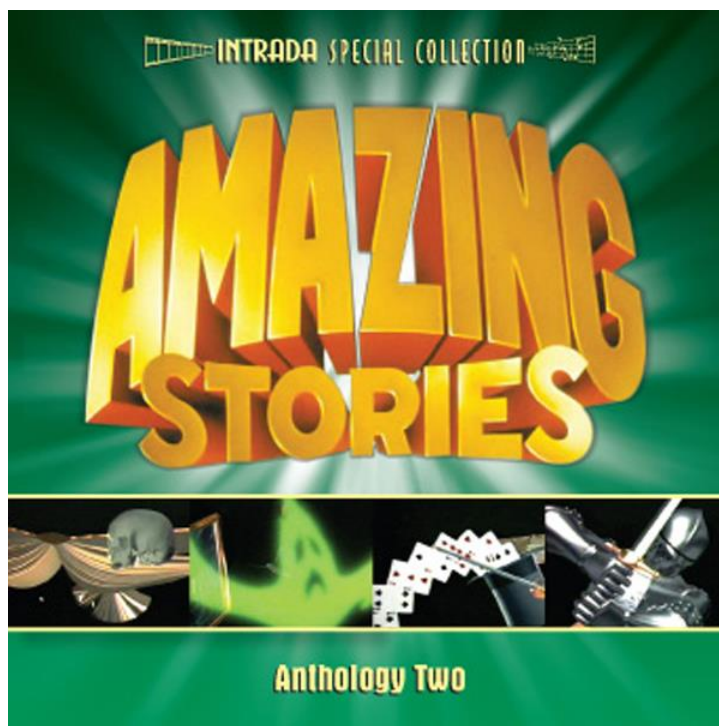

Intrada Special Collection Volume ISC 34

Following Intrada's recent release of *Amazing Stories - Anthology 1*, comes the eagerly anticipated Anthology 2. This 2-CD set showcases another stunning lineup of composers for more episodes from Steven Spielberg's mid-80s television series about the fantastic. Highlighting are Goldsmith's warm and quirky "Boo!", Rosenman's powerful "No Day at the Beach" and Thomas Newman's "Santa '85" with its rich orchestral tapestry anchored by no less than three hammering pianos. The set opens with an alternate version of John Williams' main theme, heard only once – at the opening of *Alamo Jobe*. The rest of the lineup is as follows:
